

BODY OF FORMER COMRADE ARRIVES

Emil Faflik's Funeral At Cleveland Monday

The body of Emil F. Faflik, brother of A. A. Faflik of the Dostal Products Co., and comrade in service of the Rainbow Division contingent of soldiers from Bucyrus, has arrived from overseas and will reach Cleveland tonight, according to a message received by A. A. Faflik of this city. Funeral occurs at the family home at 3354 West 30th street, Cleveland, Monday and A. A. Faflik leaves Sunday to attend.

The deceased was a member of Co. A, 166th Regiment, Rainbow Division, of which the Bucyrus boys were members, and lost his life on August 1, 1918 by being struck by a shell in the action at Chateau Thierry. He enlisted at Borea and went to the Mexican border with the National Guard, going into overseas service shortly after the return from the border.

He is survived by his mother, two brothers and one sister.
