We, the undersigned Commissioners, appointed by the Chamber of Commerce, Kiwanis Club and Rotary Club, to examine same submitted in connection with the removal of the Ohio Crane Company to vacant lots on the corner of Southern Avenue from Harris Avenue east to Toledo & Ohio, Localities, Railroad—about 200 feet—property on both sides of which is now owned by The Ohio Crane Company, have to report that after a careful survey of the Ohio Crane Company ground and plan:

That we consider the removal made by The Ohio Crane Company to be just and reasonable and that the ground in question should be vacated at once;

That the citizens of Bucyrus should be asked to grant this slight removal made by The Ohio Crane Company, and thereby cooperate in helping to expand the business of a Company which in normal times is one of the largest employers of labor in Bucyrus;

That to refuse the request made by The Ohio Crane Company, would be forcing them to remove property away from Bucyrus if they wish to provide for expansion in the future as they have in the past;

That it is the duty of every citizen having the welfare of Bucyrus at heart, to interest himself in this matter, after which he will be able to vote as a voter, rather than not, and should then put his shoulder to the wheel and help assist one of our major manufacturers and thereby help Bucyrus;

That this report by your Commissioners is submitted.

RESOLUTION NO. 1111.
 Showing the opinion of the Council of the City of Bucyrus, Ohio, toward the vacation of Southern Avenue.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Bucyrus, Ohio, that:

Section 1. That it is the opinion of this Council that the vacation of Southern Avenue as petitioned for by The Ohio Crane Company, before the Crawford Council Commission would be one form of showing the appreciation toward the said Company for the good that it has done to the City of Bucyrus and vicinity, and that such vacation would promote the general welfare and be for the best interest of the City of Bucyrus, Ohio, and ought to be made.

Section 2. That this Commission be immediately formed and effect, and the Clerk of this body be and he is authorized to instruct to forward a copy thereof to the said Ohio Crane Company.
