### Picks Longest Day of Year For Fish Bake

The Crawford County Fish & Game Protective & Distributive association has decided on a fish bake, to be held in the Dobbins & Geiger grove northeast of this city on the evening of June 21st. The club has selected the longest day of the year for the affair, at which it is expected that possibly 500 members will be present.

Arrangements are in the hands of the entertainment committee, composed of F. A. (Heck) Roelle, Chas. E. Geiger, Fred J. Phelps and George Ryan. It is proposed to have this affair surpass anything which the club has thus far attempted.

Eighty new members were listed at the special meeting held Tuesday night, showing that the membership campaign of the club is making very rapid headway and indicating that the 500 membership mark at which the soliciting members are "shoot-ing" will very probably be reached without much of a struggle. Ralph Garner turned in the most names at this meeting, Garner having signed up 41, while Sam Reeder was not far behind with 29. President J. J. Houseberg presided at the session and the minutes were taken by Justice C. L. Spriggs, secretary of the club.

The distributive committee, A. A. Faffik, H. G. F. Walther, William Kranich, Stanley (Buck) Davis and Glenn C. Cox, formally reported the visit of the state fish car here recently and the distribution of eight cans of the finest fish which have ever come to the county from this source. There were black bass in the shipment 15 inches long, it is reported.
