

**MILK PRICES SLASHED
IN BUCYRUS TODAY**

**Dostal Company An-
nounces 20 Per Cent
Cut**

BECAME EFFECTIVE TODAY

**Not Result of Milk War But Effort
To Make Living Costs Less to Con-
sumer, Statement of Manager of
Dostal Products Dairy.—Compet-
ing Concern to Cut Price Tuesday.**

The price of milk in Bucyrus was cut 20 per cent this morning when the Dostal Products Co., wagons began deliveries on their first trip today at ten cents per quart and five cents per pint.

A. A. Faflik of the dairy department of the Dostal organization stated today that the reason for the price of milk was an effort to meet the unusual conditions prevailing, the shortage of employment and the general high level of costs making a strained situation to many people. He further stated that in a district surrounding Bucyrus, lower wholesale prices for milk have prevailed and so it was decided to lower the wholesale cost here to make it possible to cut the cost to the consumer.

The producers supplying the Dostal dairy have shown an admirable disposition to assist in the reduction. Mr. Faflik says, and practically all of them have agreed promptly to the cut, which amounts to a cent a quart to the producer, the Dostal company assuming the extra one cent cut on the quart itself.

The news of the cut in milk prices will be welcome to the consumers, which means practically everybody in Bucyrus. The price set by the Dostal Co., will prevail general here, it develops, as the Dairy Products Co., announced today a similar cut, effective Tuesday morning.

The reduction made by the Dostal company is not a move in a local "milk war" Mr. Faflik stated, but is made to meet conditions and the company itself is assuming 50 per cent of the reduction.
